

The Maryland Society for Clinical Social Work is approved by the Maryland Board of Social Work Examiners to award continuing education credits for social workers. This continuing education program is also approved by the Maryland Board of Professional Counselors and Therapists for Category A.

For out-of-state participants, each individual State Board determines the appropriate category for CEUs achieved. It is the responsibility of the participant to contact the Board in their state to determine which category is correct for CEUs awarded in Maryland. If the recipient is not a social worker, their certificate can be presented to the appropriate Board for consideration of CEUs in that discipline.

Under certain circumstances we will issue a Certificate of Attendance. Specific request must be made in advance.

## DIRECTIONS TO LOCATIONS

**Timonium: 1954 Green Spring Road.** From the Baltimore Beltway, use Exit #24, I-83 North. Go to the first exit, #16, Timonium Road, bear right. Stay in right lane, make right turn onto Green Spring Road. Pass Crowne Plaza on right; turn right into service road. Pass one-story office buildings on left; at end of service road, green sign indicates "1954"; the University is a large blue-green glass building ahead and to the left closest to the side of I-83.

**Columbia: 8830 Stanford Blvd.** Located in the Village of Owen Brown, Columbia Corporate Park. From Route 29, exit east onto Little Patuxent Parkway, Route 175. Turn right onto Dobbin Road. Follow Dobbin Road to intersection of McGaw Road. Turn left onto McGaw, and then left again onto Stanford Blvd. From I-95, take Exit #41 west, Route 175, Little Patuxent Parkway. Pass Route 108 and Snowden River Parkway. Turn left onto Dobbin Road and follow remainder of directions above.

## REFRESHMENTS
